

11. A \$35.00 fee will be charged for any non-sufficient fund or stop payment check that is returned by a bank. Issuer of the check will be responsible for legal expenses.
12. Sleeping or cell phone usage is not allowed during observation.
13. Attitude and maturity is an important part of this course. Any student who is found to be DISRUPTIVE and/or DISRESPECTFUL to the instructor, other students, or anyone associated with Coach Beverley's Driving School shall be dismissed by the instructor at the instructor's discretion with no refund.
14. Any student suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs while attending class or road instruction will be immediately dismissed from the program. A conference will be held with their parents/guardian as well as the local law enforcement officials being contacted. No REFUND from the program will be given.
15. It is the responsibility of the student or in case of minor the parent /legal guardian to report to the Department of Motor Vehicles any concerns regarding school facilities, instructor behavior, or quality of instruction provided by the school.
16. Before you receive your Provisional Drivers License you must complete 45 hours of driving consisting of 30 daylight hours and 15 hours after sunset. Student must complete at least 45 hours of log time before driving with an instructor.

By signing this contract you agree that you have read and agree with the conditions listed in this contract and will abide by all condition. It should be emphasized that successful completion of a driver education program does not and should not imply that your child is a safe accomplished driver. During the course, students are instructed in the basic skills necessary for the safe operation of a motor vehicle. However, as with any skills it is only repeated practice that the skill is developed and perfected. Your continued work with your son/daughter is essential to further development of sound driving skills. It is mandatory that you provide your child with a minimum of 30 daylight hours and 15 after sunset hours of additional supervised behind the wheel driving conducted before the program completion. As the parent you must make the ultimate decision to determine if your child is ready to handle the responsibility of operating a motor vehicle.

_____, the parent/ legal guardian of _____, agree that my son/ daughter may be provided in-car instruction on an individual (one-on-one) basis with only the instructor and the student present in the vehicle, and that the School will make every effort to schedule with more than one child in the vehicle. I also acknowledge that all behind the wheel training will be with a certified instructor. And instruction will be given in a dual control vehicle, which has a dual brake pedal on the right hand side for instructors use, an extra rear view mirrors and student driver sign posted on the vehicle.
