Coach Beverley, and his staff goal in this program is to prepare competent, skillful, and responsible young drivers who will have the correct attitude toward safe driving. However, understand that completion of this course does not imply that your son/daughter is an accomplished driver. The skill of driving takes several years to master.

The Following conditions must be understood before enrolling:

- Course consists of minimum of 14 periods of Behind-The-Wheel instruction for students under 18 years of age. (7periods of observation and 7 periods of actual driving). Cost will be _____ payable by cash or money order to Coach Beverley's Driving School.
- 2. Additional Behind-The-Wheel lessons are available at \$50.00per hour.
- 3. Pick up available at local High Schools, this includes Hampton, Newport News, Yorktown, and Williamsburg/James City County. We also serve Gloucester County, Middlesex County, Matthews County, New Kent, and West Point. Pricing may vary depending on pick up location.
- 4. Students 17 years of age and under are required to complete state approved driver's education program, which is 36 hours of classroom instruction. (Students 18 and older must hold their learners permit for 60 days in lieu of completing a driver training course).
- 5. A refund of all fees paid will be made upon request, if school is not capable of or willing to begin instruction within 30 calendar days from the date of agreed contract.
- 6. This contract is valid for 12 months from the first driving lesson.
- 7. A minimum of 24 hours is required for cancelations of Behind-The-Wheel lessons, in case of an emergency please notify us as soon as possible.
- 8. Behind-The-Wheel Course can take up to four weeks to complete.
- 9. Students will be notified by phone in the event the school cancels classes. Cancelled classes will be made up as soon as slots become available.
- 10. School does not guarantee that any student will pass the state license examination or that the student can secure a license or that student will be guaranteed employment upon completion of any course instructions.

- 11. A \$35.00 fee will be charged for any non-sufficient fund or stop payment check that is returned by a bank. Issuer of the check will be responsible for legal expenses.
- 12. Sleeping or cell phone usage is not allowed during observation.
- 13. Attitude and maturity is an important part of this course. Any student who is found to be DISRUPTIVE and/or DISRESPECTFUL to the instructor, other students, or anyone associated with Coach Beverley's Driving School shall be dismissed by the instructor at the instructors discretion with no refund.
- 14. Any student suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs while attending class or road instruction will be immediately dismissed from the program. A conference will be held with their parents/guardian as well as the local law enforcement officials being contacted. No REFUND from the program will be given.
- 15. It is the responsibility of the student on in case of minor the parent /legal guardian to report to the Department of Motor Vehicles any concerns regarding school facilities, instructor behavior, or quality of instruction provided by the school.
- 16. Before you receive your Provisional Drivers License you must complete 45 hours of driving consisting of 30 daylight hours and 15 hours after sunset. Student must complete at least 45 hours of log time before driving with an instructor.

By signing this contract you agree that you have read and agree with the conditions listed in this contract and will abide by all condition. It should be emphasized that successful completion of a driver education program does not and should not imply that your child is a safe accomplished driver. During the course, students are instructed in the basic skills necessary for the safe operation of a motor vehicle. However, as with any skills it is only repeated development of sound driving skills. It is mandatory that you provide your child with a minimum of 30 daylight hours and 15 after sunset hours of additional supervised behind the wheel driving conducted before the program completion. As the parent you must make the ultimate decision to determine if your child is ready to handle the responsibility of operating a motor vehicle.
